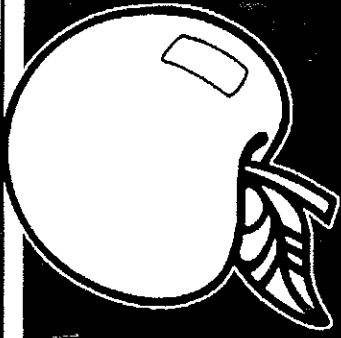

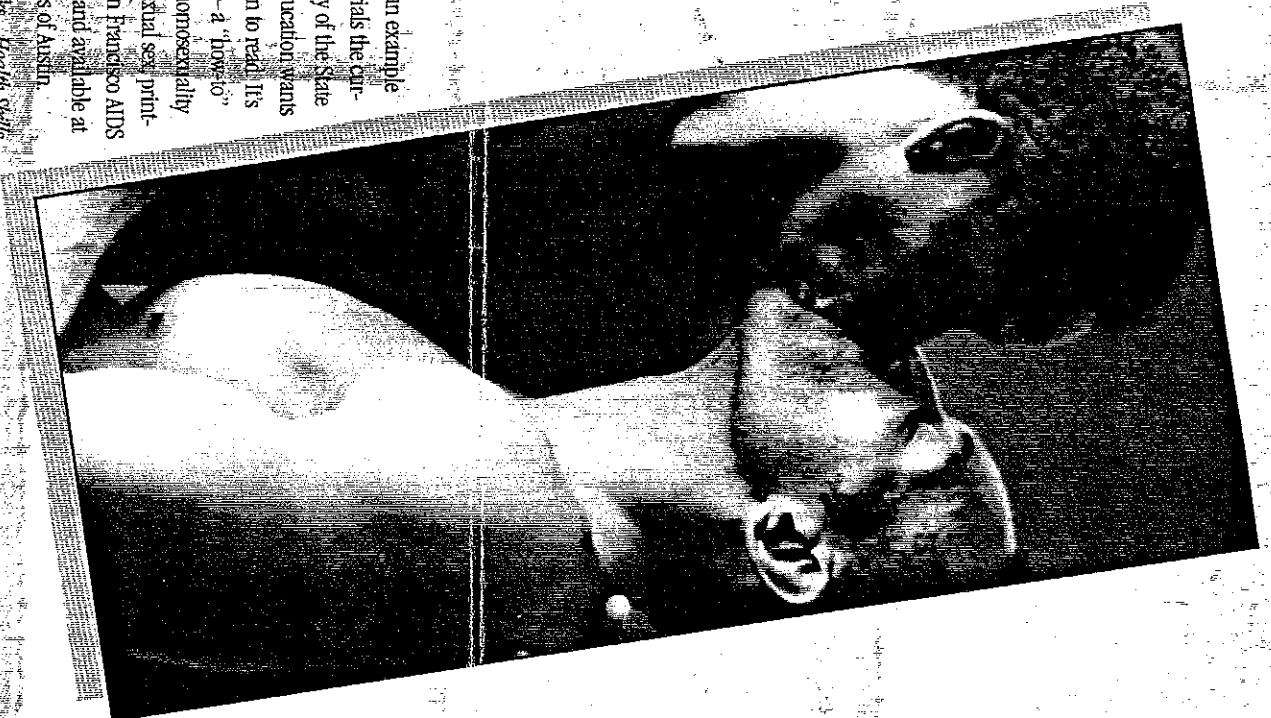

Homosexuality. Lesbian Adoption. Condom Usage.

Do you want your children learning about this in school? The liberals on the State Board of Education do.

The radical homosexual lobby and other liberal special interests pressured the State Board of Education to adopt a teaching manual that trumpets their liberal values.
